

Notice from the administrator of the Swissair Group to creditors and the media

Successful start of second phase of inflight material sale off – Trolleys and watches available for first time

Küsnacht-Zurich, 22 November 2002. The second phase of the sale of Swissair inflight material by the Kurt Hoss company (website: www.hossliquidator.ch) began successfully on 20 November 2002. Owing to the large volume of goods on sale, most items are still available, although ski suits, safety vests, sports bags, shoulder bags, adult baseball caps, games sets, inflatable aircraft, air beds, chocolate, coffee cups bearing the Swissair logo, wine coolers and silvered soup, coffee and mocha spoons have all sold out. Going on sale for the first time are 3,500 Longines watches, binoculars, travel alarm clocks, calculators, 1,200 trolleys, a small number of old uniforms, golf travel bags and golf bag raincovers.

Goods worth around CHF 2.5 million were sold during the first three weeks of the sale, while the sale venue was visited by an estimated 70,000 or so people.

The sale of office fittings and IT equipment is scheduled to begin in January 2003. Exact details will be announced in due course.

The sale venue at Grindelstrasse 9 in 8303 Bassersdorf is open on weekdays between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm, as well as on Saturdays between 9.00 am and 3.00 pm. It will remain closed on Sundays.
