

Notice from the administrator of Swissair Group to creditors and the media

First responses to the invitation to register debts – administrator welcomes delisting of Swissair securities

Küsnacht, Zurich, 18 January 2002. The administrator of SAirGroup, SAirLines, Swissair Schweizerische Luftverkehr AG and Flightlease AG, Mr Karl Wüthrich, of Wenger Plattner, and his team have been answering more than a hundred inquiries a day, mainly from creditors, since the invitations to register debts were issued on 9 January 2002. These inquiries are referred to the administrator by e-mail (info@wenger-plattner.ch) or via the hotline (English: +41-1-914 27 50; French: +41-1-914 27 40; German: +41-1-914 27 30). The administrator's website (www.sachwalter-swissair.ch) has recorded up to 2000 visits a day - sometimes more. Several hundred claim registrations have already been received, and the administrator expects a sharp rise in this influx next week.

Delisting of Swissair securities

At the request of SAirGroup, the Swiss Stock Exchange SWX will delist SWX-listed equities and Swiss franc bonds with effect from the end of January. The administrator welcomes this decision, which will make the debt-restructuring procedure much easier, not least because the obligation of *ad hoc* publicisation will cease to apply.
